- 4. Please fill out the attached form. You may sell your work and the Senior Games Committee will take no commission but will only put you in touch with your buyer.
- 5. All work must be original no reproduction prints.
- 6. The Senior Games Committee reserves the right to reject any piece for any reason.
- All work with paperwork, must be submitted to the Park's Office,
   State Route 416, Montgomery, NY by 4:00 pm on Mon., Sept. 10, 2012.
   NO WORK WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THE DEADLINE.
- 8. Your work will be judged by a jury and awards will be presented on Sept. 12. All work must be clearly marked with the artist's name, title, medium, and contact information (name, address, phone and email address).
- 9. All artists should submit a one page **bio** to be included in the Artist's Book.
- Your work will be handled by experienced art professionals. However, the Committee assumes no liability for theft or damage either during installation or exhibition.
- 11. You must pick up your work by Wednesday, September 19 by 4:00 pm.
